## **Welcome to the Mt. Lebanon Artists' Market!**

We're excited to showcase outstanding creative talent and bring the community together through the arts.

Participating artists play a vital role in creating a professional, welcoming, and enjoyable experience for everyone. The guidelines below help ensure a smooth and successful event.

## **Event Expectations**

### **Setup & Breakdown**

Please follow all setup and load-out instructions provided prior to the event. Arrival windows and logistics are carefully scheduled to ensure a safe and efficient experience for all artists.

### **Booth Operations**

- Booths must remain open and staffed for the full event hours
- Displays must stay within assigned booth spaces
- Walkways and neighboring booths must remain clear
- Artists are responsible for leaving their space clean at the end of the event

### **Artwork & Sales**

- Only original work in the genre approved through the jury process may be sold
- Artists are responsible for collecting and remitting applicable sales tax
- Any required permits or licenses are the responsibility of the artist

## **Community Standards**

Artists are ambassadors of the event and are expected to:

- Treat guests, fellow artists, volunteers, and staff with courtesy and respect
- Foster a welcoming and inclusive atmosphere
- Bring any concerns to event staff so they can be addressed promptly

Conduct that disrupts the event or negatively impacts the experience of others may result in removal from the event or ineligibility for future participation.



## **Promotion & Representation**

Artists are encouraged to promote their participation in the Artists' Market.

The Artists' Market is a non-political community event. Promotional materials and social media posts connected to the event should not include political endorsements or messaging.

## **Inclusivity Commitment**

The Mt. Lebanon Partnership is committed to providing a welcoming environment for all participants and visitors. Harassment, discrimination, or hostile behavior of any kind will not be tolerated.

## **Enforcement**

The Mt. Lebanon Partnership reserves the right to address conduct concerns during the event, request modification of booth displays, remove participants whose behavior violates event standards, and decline future participation if conduct is inconsistent with event expectations.
